Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the cost of the well pump replacement installation from Knight Well Drilling in the amount of \$6,250.92. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye. John Seese made a motion to advertise for bids for temporary heating at the school. Todd Nemura, Director of Resource Development for the Pocono Mountains United Way was present to ask the Supervisors to consider allocating up to \$5,000 of the annual budget to help ensure the United Way's Pocono Info helpline. The Pocono Info Helpline is a program used to connect people with services they may need such as housing assistance, cash assistance and basic needs assistance.
