Re: 911 Address Sign

Dear Barrett Township Resident:

On October 26, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 167, requiring all residents to display a 911 Address sign in accordance with the Monroe County Readdressing project. It has been brought to our attention by the emergency agencies that serve Barrett Township, that there are many residences that do not have these signs, making it difficult to find the correct house to provide emergency services.

If you do not currently have a 911 Address Sign, you must order one through the Township's Administrative Office, the cost is \$25. For your convenience an order form is enclosed. You can drop off the order form and fee at the Municipal Building or mail the form and fee to: Barrett Township, 993 Route 390, Cresco, PA 18326. The Maintenance Department will install the sign.

If you do not order a 911 Address Sign within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter, the Township will order the sign and install it and you will be billed \$ 50.00 for the sign and the installation. Once the sign is installed by the Township, you will have thirty (30) days to pay the invoice or further action will be taken with the District Magistrate's Office and additional fees could be incurred.

If you have already installed a 911 Address Sign, please contact me so I can confirm the sign is in place and your name will be removed from the list.
