

**Barrett Township Supervisors  
April 10, 2019**

**A regular meeting of the Barrett Township Supervisors was held on Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at the Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome, PA. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman William Pipolo, Jr.**

**Present: William Pipolo, Jr., Grant Hilfiger, John Seese, Solicitor Todd Weitzmann, Pam Gardsy, Jeryl Rinehart and the public. Benjie Labar and Patti O’Keefe were absent.**

**There were no public comments on the agenda items.**

**The minutes of the March 27, 2019 meeting were approved on a motion made by William Pipolo, Jr. and seconded by Grant Hilfiger and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.**

**William Pipolo, Jr. made a motion to approve the payment of the following bills:**

**The motion was seconded by Grant Hilfiger and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.**

**b. The Ambulance Report was read. There were 36 calls in Barrett Township bringing the year to date total to 122 and 531 total responses throughout all townships for the month of March with a year to date total of 1,558. On a motion made by William Pipolo, Jr. and seconded by John Seese and carried, the report was accepted as read.**

**c. The Treasurer’s Report was read. On a motion made by William Pipolo, Jr. and seconded by Grant Hilfiger and carried, the report was accepted as read.**

**d. The Police Report for March was read. On a motion made by William Pipolo, Jr. and seconded by John Seese and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.**

**Old Business:**

**a. The Monroe County Earth Day will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Monroe Campus Northampton Community College.**

**New Business:**

**a. William Pipolo, Jr. made a motion to approve the payroll for March 26, 2019 in the amount of \$ 23,064.68 for gross wages, \$ 707.33 for state liability, \$ 5,874.73 for federal tax liability and \$ 17,931.18 for net wages. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.**

A letter was received from the Monroe County Board of Assessment informing the Supervisors that during the countywide reassessment process and as the County converts to a new assessment software system, the Assessment Office will temporarily suspend issuing interim assessments as of July 2019.**

**b. A letter was received from A.W.S.O.M. asking the Supervisors for consideration of financial assistance for their animal shelter.**

**Miscellaneous:**

**a. It was noted that a certificate of insurance was received from Sands Door Company, Inc.**
