

Barrett Township Supervisors  
Minutes of Regular Meeting on June 8, 2022

A regular meeting of the Barrett Township Supervisors was held on Wednesday, June 8, 2022, at the Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome, PA. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman Pam Gardsy.

Present: Pam Gardsy, Patti O'Keefe, John Seese, Darryl Speicher, Solicitor Todd Weitzmann, Jeryl Rinehart and the public. Kelly Slinger was absent.  
There were no public comments on the agenda items.

The Minutes of the May 25, 2022 Meeting were approved contingent on the change of the pronoun from "she to he" on a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the payment of the following bills:

- May 25, 2022 - General Fund - \$ 53,693.90, Park and Recreation Fund - \$ 1,746.06, Open Space Fund - \$ 173.10, Fire Fund - \$ 461.00
- June 1, 2022 - General Fund - \$ 106,581.91, Park and Recreation Fund - \$ 1,746.49, Fire Fund - \$ 11,139.38, Library Fund - \$ 4,280.63, Ambulance Fund - \$ 1,425.20, Open Space Fund - \$ 165.13, State Fund - \$ 1,194.24

The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

Reports:

a. The S.E.O. (8), Zoning (7) and Building (14) Reports for May were read. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by John Seese and carried, the reports were accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. The Treasurer's Report for May was read. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

c. The Ambulance Report was read. For the month of May, PMR EMS responded to 62 incidents in Barrett Township bringing the year-to-date to 233. PMR EMS responded to a total of 577 incidents in May bringing the year-to-date to 2,979. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Patti O'Keefe and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

Old Business:

a. Pam Gardsy gave an update on the Golten Property. John Seese made a motion to drill the well, perform soil testing and perk testing. The motion was seconded by Pam Gardsy and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. The discussion on the Unsafe Structures at the Congregation OHR Menachem, 180 Glenmere Road was tabled for Executive Session.

c. It was noted that the Supervisors will be reviewing the Zoning Codification information at the Workshop on Wednesday, June 15, 2022.

New Business:

a. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the payroll for May 31, 2022, in the amount of \$ 17,833.13 for gross wages, \$ 547.48 for state liability, \$ 4,378.61 for federal tax liability and \$ 13,982.91 for net wages. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

Correspondence:

a. A letter was received from PA DEP informing the Supervisors that they received notification that the spill prevention equipment (spill bucket) for Tank 002 & 004 failed the integrity test at Starners Quick Shoppes, 1099 Route 390.

b. A flyer was received from the Monroe County Municipal Waste Authority informing the Supervisors that they will be holding a Household Hazardous Waste Event on June 15, July 13, July 20, July 23, August 10, August 24, and September 21 at the Military Road Recycling Site at 1114 Military Road in Stroudsburg.

Miscellaneous:

a. It was noted that there were no certificates of insurance.

Pam Gardsy made a motion to go into Executive Session at 5:51 p.m. to discuss possible litigation. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

John Seese made a motion to reconvene the meeting at 6:10 p.m. The motion was seconded by Pam Gardsy and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

As there was no further business or public comment, Pam Gardsy made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:11 p.m. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.
