

**Barrett Township Supervisors
Minutes of Workshop Meeting of October 21, 2020**

A Workshop Meeting of the Barrett Township Supervisors was held on Wednesday, October 21, 2020 at the Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome, PA. The Supervisors met at 8:00 a.m.

Present: Patti O'Keefe, Benjie LaBar, May LaBar, William Pipolo, Jr. John Seese, Pam Gardsy, Jeryl Rinehart and the public.

John Seese gave an update on the Old Canadensis Hill Bridge Project. Two trees will be removed because they interfere with the bridge abutment. Leeward Construction, Inc. will provide a time schedule for starting the project and it will be dependent on the weather. PennDot inspections will be done on the bridge as necessary. It was noted that the Performance Bond was received.

Discussion was held on the Road Inspections and possible roads to be paved for 2021.

It was noted that the Budget Workshop will be on Wednesday, November 18, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.

Discussion was held on the Franchise Agreement with Blue Ridge Cable.

Discussion was held on advertising for the Intent to hire a Professional Auditor.

Discussion was held on Solicitor Todd Weitzmann looking into the cost of doing a codification of the Zoning Ordinances.

John Seese gave an update on Community Park at Ice Lake. They are working on the bathroom and the parking lot is completed. P.P. & L will be installing a pole for the electric to run to.

May LaBar reported that she has completed the filing and the records in the safe have been updated. The Supervisors recommended for May to work in the office on an as-needed basis and in January, follow up with the Record Retention process.

Jeryl Rinehart gave an update on the Short Term Rental status. She reported that there are currently two property owner who have not applied for the Short Term Rental Permit and she will follow through with the violation of the Ordinance.

Benjie LaBar stated that she has received several complaints about fireworks going off late at night and the possibility of adopting a noise ordinance.

Jeryl Rinehart gave an update on the status of the violations at the old Pine Hollow property at 1374 Route 390. Jeryl reported that the Magistrate held an eviction hearing on September 28th, an Order of Possession on October 10th and a forceful eviction by the Constable on the 11th day of the serving of the Order of Possession.

Jeryl Rinehart will follow up with Building Code Officer, Shawn McGlynn on the change of ownership of the Unsafe Structure at 4767 Route 447.
