WHEREAS the population of Barrett Township is approximately 3,273, and

WHEREAS the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the Boards of Supervisors of the various Townships of the Second Class to determine the compensation of Supervisors subject to the limitation set forth in the Act.

Now therefore it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Such compensation shall be paid in quarterly installments.

3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon enactment.

BARRETT Whereas the population of Pocono Township is approximately 5,782, and

Whereas the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the Boards of Supervisors of the various Townships of the Second Class to determine the compensation of Supervisors subject to the limitation set forth in the act.

Now therefore it is hereby enacted and ordained as follow:

- 1. Each Supervisor of Pecono Township elected or appointed to office on or after November 1, 1989, shall receive compensation as a Supervisor in the annual amount of \$2,000.00, Based on 27 meeting par year @ 40.00 par meeting
- 2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly Quarterly installments.
 - 3. This Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 1986.
