

**BARRETT TOWNSHIP  
MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**ORDINANCE NO. 127**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, COUNTY OF MONROE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF A CUL-DE-SAC ON HIGH ROAD SITUATE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, CONTAINING 3,863 SQUARE FEET, MORE OR LESS; AND DIRECTING THAT THE VACATED PORTION OF THE CUL-DE-SAC ON HIGH ROAD BE STRICKEN FROM THE OFFICIAL TOWNSHIP MAP.**

WHEREAS, Barrett Township (the "Township") became the fee simple owner of certain real property situate in the Township of Barrett, including a cul-de-sac on High Road, pursuant to Resolution dated September 8, 1982 accepting a deed of dedication executed and delivered to the Township by James S. Price and Alice Price, his wife, and Harry F. Price and Katherine Price, his wife, on August 16, 1982, and;

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Barrett Township deem it to be in the best interests, and for the general welfare, of the citizens and residents of the Township to vacate a portion of said cul-de-sac on High Road, as hereinafter more particularly described, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, to wit:

SECTION 1. Title: This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Barrett Township Vacation of a Portion of a Cul-de-sac on High Road Ordinance."

SECTION 2. Portion of Road to be Vacated. All interests held by the Township in the below-described portion of the cul-de-sac on High Road in Barrett Township are hereby vacated by the Township:

ALL THAT CERTAIN portion of a cul-de-sac on High Road, situate in the Township of Barrett, County of Monroe, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southeasterly right-of-way line of High Road, said point being the northeast corner of Lot 31, Mill Creek Estates Section 3, recorded in and for the County of Monroe in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Map Book 44, Page 51; thence along the right-of-way line of a cul-de-sac on High Road on a curve to the right having a radius of 50.00 feet and arc length of 153.23 feet (the chord bearing and distance being N 46° 26' 58" E 99.93 feet) to a point; thence through, over and across said cul-de-sac, parallel to and 25 feet southeasterly from the center line of

High Road on a curve to the right having a radius of 325.00 feet an arc length of 50.05 feet (the chord bearing and distance being N 44° 14' 37" E 50.00 feet) to a point, the center of said cul-de-sac; thence along same, N 48° 39' 19" E. 50.00 feet to the place of BEGINNING. Containing 3863 square feet, more or less.

Being part of High Road as recorded in Deed Book 1206, Page 241 and accepted by resolution of the Barrett Township Board of Supervisors on September 8, 1982.

SECTION 3. Removal of Vacated Portion of Road from Township Map. The vacated portion of High Road described in Section 2 above shall be stricken from the Township Map.

SECTION 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions conflicting or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed but only insofar as same are in direct conflict or directly inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
