**ORDINANCE NO. 131**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, COUNTY OF MONROE, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION V OF ORDINANCE NO. 112 TO AUTHORIZE THE WAIVER AND ELIMINATION OF REQUIRED MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PERIOD FROM JUNE 29, 2003 TO DECEMBER 31, 2003 PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT DATED FEBRUARY 5, 1993 BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT AND THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT BOARD.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, to wit:

**SECTION 1:** Section V of Ordinance No. 112 is hereby amended only to adopt and incorporate the provisions of Section 2 hereinbelow pertaining to the waiver and elimination of required member contributions for the period from June 29, 2003 to December 31, 2003 for members participating in the police pension plan. Any and all provisions of Ordinance No. 112, as amended, not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 2:** The proper officers of the Township of Barrett are hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents and to do all other acts that may be necessary and proper to authorize, for the period from June 29, 2003 to December 31, 2003, the waiver and elimination of required member contributions to the police pension plan as set forth in Paragraph 9 of the Agreement dated February 5, 1993, between the Township of Barrett and the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board.

**SECTION 3:** A duly certified copy of this ordinance amending Ordinance No. 112 shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**SECTION 4:** The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall become effective five days after enactment.

**Resolution**

At a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, held at the Barrett Township Municipal Building, R.R. #2, Cresco, Monroe County, Pennsylvania 18326, on the 24 day of June, 2003, at 9:30 a.m., the following Resolution was duly made, seconded and adopted:

WHEREAS, Barrett Township (the "Township"), by Ordinance No. 112, entered into and accepted the Agreement dated February 5, 1993 (the "Agreement"), with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board (the "Board") to provide a police pension plan; and,

WHEREAS, Paragraph 9 of the Agreement requires members of the police pension plan to contribute five (5%) percent of their total compensation to the plan, but authorizes the Township annually to elect to waive the said required member contributions by adopting a resolution and filing it with the Board; and,

WHEREAS, Section 772 of Act 600 (53 P.S. §772) further authorizes the Township annually by ordinance or resolution to eliminate payments into the police pension plan by members; and,

WHEREAS, Township Ordinance No. 131, authorizes the proper officers of the Township to take all necessary and proper action to waive and eliminate the required member contributions for the period from June 29, 2003 to December 31, 2003 for members participating in the police pension plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, in accordance with the above mentioned authority, the Township hereby agrees to waive and eliminate, for the period from June 29, 2003 to December 31, 2003, the required member contributions to the police pension plan as set forth in Paragraph 9 of the Agreement dated February 5, 1993, between the Township of Barrett and the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a duly certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board to so indicate the Township's intent.
