ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, COUNTY OF MONROE, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING BARRETT TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 125 AND ESTABLISHING STATUTORY 25 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS WITHIN BARRETT TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Act 1998-151, Act of December 21, 1998, P.L. 1126, No. 151, found at 75 Pa.C.S. §3362(a)(1.2) and §3363, authorizes Pennsylvania municipalities, subject to 75 Pa.C.S. § 6109(e), to set the speed limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour on certain locally-owned roads without a prior engineering and traffic study; and

WHEREAS, certain roads exist within Barrett Township, a Pennsylvania second class township (the "Township"), where no speed limits have been established or where conditions warrant a reduction of the speed limits previously adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township deems it to be in the best interests, and for the general welfare, of the citizens and residents of the Township to enact twenty-five (25) miles per hour speed limits on certain roads in the Township pursuant to Act 1998-151;

WHEREAS, the within Ordinance is intended to amend existing Barrett Township Ordinance Number 125 by establishing 25 miles per hour speed limits on additional Township roads.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, to wit:

SECTION 1: Title. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Barrett Township Statutory 25 MPH Speed Limit Ordinance Amendment."

SECTION 2: Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Roads. The following speed limits are hereby established:

<u>Road</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>
Old Canadensis Road	entire length	25
Wiebolt Road	entire length	25

SECTION 3: Enforcement. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Barrett Township Police Department or any other authorized police officer in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.


SECTION 4: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5: Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions conflicting or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed but only insofar as same are in direct conflict or directly inconsistent with this Ordinance.


SECTION 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.

TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT



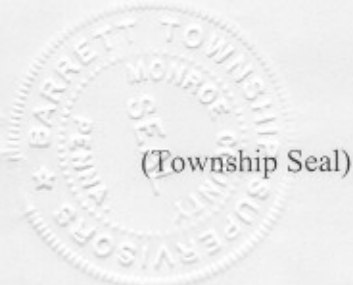


