ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING BARRETT TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 167 TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR STREET SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED AS PART OF A COORDINATED AND UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR 911 (EMERGENCY) STREET AND BUILDING NUMBER SIGN REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the general powers permitted by the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. § 65101), and power to regulate the numbering of buildings (53 P.S. §66520) and the naming of streets (53 P.S. § 67329), the following:

SECTION 1. - SHORT TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the “Barrett Township E-911 Street and Building Number Sign Ordinance Amendment.”

SECTION 2. – AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE 167.

Barrett Township Ordinance 167 is hereby amended to add the following new sub-paragraph C as follows:

- C. Street Sign Regulations. Except as set forth herein, all signs identifying public and private streets located within Barrett Township shall be depicted in three (3) inch tall reflective white lettering on a green background.
 - a. Exception: For private streets located in private communities with at least 100 homes, streets signs may be depicted in three (3) inch tall reflective white lettering on a brown background. The decision to install green or brown street signs may be made by the governing body of the private community in its sole discretion and at its sole cost and expense. Streets signs shall be uniformly green or brown throughout a single private community.

SECTION 3. - SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or section is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the legislative

intent that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provisions had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. – REPEALER.

Except as hereby amended, Barrett Township Ordinance 167 shall remain in full force and effect. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. – EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
