ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE BARRETT TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, TO REVISE THE ZONING MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT, AND TO ALLOW IN M-1 ZONING DISTRICTS HEAVY EQUIPMENT STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE FACILITIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1: Section 2.200 of the Barrett Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

ZONING MAP

The location and boundaries of said zoning districts are hereby established as shown on the Zoning Map of the Township of Barrett, dated February 1986, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and hereby made a part of this Ordinance. The said map and all notations, references, and designations shown thereon shall be as much a part of this Ordinance as if the same were all fully described and set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Section 3.140 of the Barrett Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add the following subparagraph as follows:


- e. Heavy equipment storage and maintenance facilities.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its enactment.
