

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR THE STORAGE, COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE BY AND WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF BARRETT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Barrett Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1. Barrett Township Ordinance No. 53, No. 58 and No. 61, all of which establish fees for the storage, collection and disposal of refuse by and within the Township of Barrett, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
