

**Barrett Township Supervisors
December 11, 2013**

A Public Hearing was held by the Barrett Township Supervisors on Wednesday, December 11, 2013 at the Barrett Township Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome to discuss any changes to the Zoning Ordinance and to receive public comments on the final draft. The hearing was opened at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Ralph Megliola.

Present: Ralph Megliola, Loree Guthrie, John Seese, Paul Stotsenburg, William Pipolo, Jr., Solicitor Deborah Hoffman, Township Engineer Judy Stern Goldstein, Jeryl Rinehart and the public.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is for the opportunity for the public to comment on the Final Draft of the Zoning Ordinance.

Martin Price asked if the Ordinance would be in word format so changes could be made in the future. Judy confirmed that it would be in word format.

Judy stated, that in the comments of the Monroe County Planning Commission review letter, there was a typographical error in the parking standards and number sequences on pages 13-4 and 13-5 that needed to be corrected.

Patti O'Keefe said that the comments that she submitted had been addressed and asked if the Planning Commission comments had be addressed. Judy confirmed that the comments had been addressed.

Solicitor Deborah Huffman noted that the Public Hearing has been advertised in the Pocono Record, a copy of the Ordinance was provided to the Law Library and was made available to the public to review beforehand.

Ralph Megliola made a motion to adopt new Zoning Ordinance. The motion was seconded by William Pipolo, Jr. and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

As there was no further business or public comment, Ralph Megliola made a motion to close the Public Hearing at 6:45 p.m. The motion was seconded by Paul Stotsenburg and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.
