

BARRETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF AUDITORS
REORGANIZATIONAL MEETING - JANUARY 6, 2026

The reorganization meeting of the Barrett Township Auditors was held on Tuesday, January 6, 2026 at the BARC Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome, PA at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Nate Covington followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
