

**Barrett Township Supervisors  
Minutes of Regular Meeting on December 11, 2024**

A Regular Meeting of the Barrett Township Supervisors was held on Wednesday, December 11, 2024, at the Municipal Building on Route 390 in Cresco, PA. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman Pam Gardsy.

Present: Pam Gardsy, Kelly Slinger, Patti O'Keefe, John Seese, Darryl Speicher, Solicitor Todd Weitzmann, Jeryl Rinehart, and the public.

There were no public comments on the agenda items.

The Minutes of the Regular Meeting for November 27, 2024, were approved on a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the payment of the following bills:

The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

**Reports:**

a. The Treasurer's Report for November was read. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. The S.E.O. (4), Zoning (14) and Building (18) Reports for November were read. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried, the reports were accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

c. The Monthly Call Statistics for November were received from the Monroe County Control Center. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Kelly Slinger and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the 2025 Proposed Budget and to adopt Resolution No. 121124, Fixing the Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2025. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

c. Pam Gardsy made a motion to advertise hiring Riley and Company to perform the 2024 Audit. The motion was seconded by Kelly Slinger and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

d. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the Eagle Scout Project for T.J. Planker. The motion was seconded by John Seese and carried. All Supervisors voted aye. The project will include building a trellis for outdoor weddings near the District Magistrate office.

e. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the Eagle Scout Project for Daniel Cunningham. The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye. The project will include renovating the old outdoor classroom with new benches and landscaping.
