

**Barrett Township Supervisors  
Minutes of Regular Meeting on November 27, 2024**

A Regular Meeting of the Barrett Township Supervisors was held on Wednesday, November 27, 2024, at the Municipal Building on Route 390 in Cresco, PA. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Pam Gardsy.

Present: Pam Gardsy, Patti O'Keefe, Kelly Slinger, Darryl Speicher, John Seese, Jeryl Rinehart, and the public.

The Regular Meeting Minutes for November 13, 2024, and the Workshop Meeting Minutes for November 20, 2024, were approved on a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the payment of the following bills:

- November 13, 2024 – General Fund - \$ 24,584.64, Park and Recreation Fund - \$ 121.60, Open Space Fund - \$ 85.00, State Fund - \$ 440.39

The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

**Reports:**

a. The Police Report for October was read. On a motion made by John Seese and seconded by Kelly Slinger and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. The Ambulance Report was read. For the month of October, PMR EMS responded to 39 incidents in Barrett Township, bringing the year-to-date to 437. PMR EMS responded to a total of 602 incidents in October, bringing the year-to-date to 5,762. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

c. The Road Report for October was read. On a motion made by Pam Gardsy and seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried, the report was accepted as read. All Supervisors voted aye.

**Old Business:**

a. Discussion was held on the septic permit application, well waiver and stormwater waiver for 2426 Route 390. Pam Gardsy made a motion to have Solicitor Todd Weitzman prepare the septic maintenance agreement. The motion was seconded by Kelly Slinger and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. It was noted that the Hurricane Relief Charity Bingo has been rescheduled to Sunday, January 12, 2025, at 1:00 p.m.

**New Business:**

a. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the payroll for November 12, 2024, in the amount of \$ 19,305.73 for gross wages, \$ 592.68 for state tax liability, \$ 4,108.30 for federal tax liability and \$ 15,197.43 for net wages. The motion was seconded by Kelly Slinger and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

b. Pam Gardsy made a motion to advertise for the Zoning Officer and Sewage Enforcement Officer part-time positions. The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

c. It was noted that there is a Public Hearing scheduled for Monday, December 16, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. for a Zoning Hearing Variance Request Application for James and Karen Brecker.

d. Discussion was held on the meeting dates for December and January. Pam Gardsy made a motion to close the office on Thursday, December 26<sup>th</sup> and Friday, December 27<sup>th</sup>, have Solicitor Todd Weitzmann advertise cancelling the meeting on Wednesday, December 25<sup>th</sup>, making the Workshop Meeting on Wednesday, December 18<sup>th</sup>, a regular meeting, and scheduling the Reorganization Meeting on Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. with the Regular Meeting immediately after. The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

e. Pam Gardsy made a motion to approve the Fireworks Permit for Skytop Lodge on Tuesday, December 31, 2024, at 10:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Darryl Speicher and carried. All Supervisors voted aye.

**Correspondence:**

a. It was noted that there was no Correspondence.

**Miscellaneous:**

a. It was noted that certificates of insurance were received from Stone Ridge Diesel LLC and Pride Mobile Homes.

Darryl Speicher reported that the Historical Society will be having an Open House at the old Friendly Community Center on December 14, 2024.
